  - **Question**: How are you going to bridge the gap between online and in person events. Also how can you manage events since not everyone will be able to attend in person?
    - Afarin: Volleyball and basketball are great sports you can do outside.
    - If things go back to online only, you could do a running competition. Everyone runs and shows how many steps they have run a day.
    - Ryan Arrowsmith: Believes it might be possible to do a hybrid online/in person event however doesn't believe this is a good idea since it'll reduce the quality of the event. He thinks it is better to do some in-person and some online events.
  - **Question**: Afarin has not been able to attend many events or committee meetings this year. Going forth, how will you better manage your time?
    - Afarin: At the start I wasn't aware of the meetings.
    - Since then, I have attended most of them.
  - **Question**: Typically members aren't interested in sports and turnout can be low. How do you encourage members to get engaged?
    - Ryan Arrowsmith: For all sports events, he will tailor them more like tryouts instead of competitive sports.
