- 2 Adoption of Previous Minutes LA
 - Unanimous adoption of previous minutes

- 3 **Semester 1 Recap** All
 - HP gives an overview: 14 events not including fresher's, 23 total
 - HP asks how people felt about semester 1
 - JA thinks it went well; bouldering was a good chance to attract more members
 - SB says we did better better than last year; thinks we retained a lot of popularity, as shown at the Christmas meal
 - SB mentioned the bar crawl potentially needing more prep but it went fine
 - S suggests we could do more to reach out to closed off groups, though that this may not be solvable in just this term
 - S suggests possibly adding more social media for outreach
 - HP says it may be a bit much to manage, but S is happy to try and figure it out
 - AA thinks it has gone pretty well and stable; Christmas meal stands out with the rainbow lasagne being a good alternative to the mushroom wellington
 - GB thinks there was better engagement across events compared to previous years; lots of smaller events has been positive; thinks bar crawl may have worked better with more contingencies

- SA says it seemed well organised, though they have no point of reference being a first year
- RJ says there were roadblocks, but committee have done well, including being a lot of events towards the event; a record number of memberships; better advertising for events this year
 - RJ says most improvements were hindsight, such as bar crawl; still did well considering the circumstances
- “No” - MW; went as well as expected to when planned
- HP is very happy with everything this semester; organisation after fresher’s slightly behind but quickly caught up

 - Latest we can do it with least issues

- **Venues**
- Responses from multiple venues since reaching out
 - Burlington is promising, but can’t remember if there were qualms
- HP thinks it’s looking positive
- MW did a viewing this morning, and it looked bigger than in the photos
- Timeline:
 - 5th January - Must have decided on a venue
 - 6th January - Paperwork ready
 - Teaser in Week 4
 - Tickets up in Week 5 (Guild pending)
 - Tickets should be off sale 2 weeks in advance
 - Last year, tickets on sale for 3.5 weeks
 - 19th February gives us 4 weeks
- SB suggests having tickets on sale for too long ruins the hype

 - HP is unsure, but we could ask about the photo booth again
- AA suggests Saturday

- HP suggests with Ball tickets being off-sale by the AGM, we can focus on the AGM before switching back to the Ball
 - SB suggests committee-elect at that time would get a chance to participate and help out

11 Hackathon All

- Provisioned for 5th & 6th
 - HP wants to move it up to the 29th and 30th of March to have Ball as the last event
 - AA suggests it's a good idea to avoid too many events in one close proximity

12 Sports Day All

- SB says we need a good time to get a shot at good weather
- SB suggests doing it after exams
 - SB mentions other society exams would need to be considered, so it would have to be completely after the exam period
 - SB says Sports Ball is also after exams, so there is likely to be an overlap with the attendees
 - HP feels it will be better after exams due to weather and attendance
- SB suggests the Sunday after exams
- HP suggests it could take place of the BBQ
 - AA suggests doing them together
- SB suggests a prize for the best society
 - Limiting number of people per society per sports event
- **Action SB: Contact societies about running after exams**

13 BBQ All

- As above, either have it replaced by sports day or mesh them together
- HP suggests the main reason we do it is for the stickers, trapping us in doing it every year
 - Last year, we had issues with the Guild
 - HP is not sure on feasibility going forward
 - SB suggests that with more time, it could become more feasible again
- SB suggests sports day TeX stickers instead of BBQ stickers
 - HP says we can consider this if it becomes a regular event
 - SB suggests we make it regular if it goes well
- In the end, we go ahead with BBQ one more time and see how it goes

14 Other Events All

- **Board Games Night 2: Electric Boogaloo**
 - RJ thinks it's worth considering whether we actually have time considering other events at the time
 - HP thinks it should be fine as it should only be RAs and

- drinks with CS
 - AA says that should still take a while with those
 - HP suggests it will still be easy enough to run, just week 1 or week 0
 - AA agrees with these dates
 - Date: 20th January
 - Can submit catering ASAP
 - Can preorder pizza with expected capacity from last year
 - Need to let TTG know in advance to avoid issues
- **Online Quiz**
 - AA asks about attendance
 - HP confirms it's usually lower, but it's a free event
 - AA thinks board game night should be a priority if we're worried about time for organisation
 - HP suggests considering it over the Easter holidays as a break from studying/revision
- **Cheese Soc**
 - Been messaged as they have been officially recognised
 - They would like us to help them get off the ground
 - RJ is happy to do it to help them out; not sure what we could do
 - AA suggests TeaSoc style event
 - AA feels like it would be an event that CheeseSoc plans, and we help fund
 - HP thinks it could be a break; event
 - GB thinks this will work well
 - GB asks if they were running events yet
 - HP confirms it was a scavenger hunt around the Christmas market, as well as chill meetings
- **break;**
 - HP thinks it's mainly figuring out the date for least overlaps
 - LA mentioned on discord that Wednesday conflicted with SANDAM's event
 - Looking at the timetable, HP thinks we might have to stick with Wednesday 1-3pm
- **TeXTalks**
 - HP suggests weeks 7-8 will be pretty free
 - SA asks what these are
 - HP explains they're our version of TED Talks
 - AA likes TeXTalks and wants them to run, but it will be an organisational nightmare; need to start now
 - SA suggests making speakers wear something purple
 - HP thinks it's not particularly feasible
 - SA suggests "subtle encouragement"
 - HP mentions there was a previous spreadsheet for speakers

- HP can reach out to someone they know
 - JA can reach out to PGRs
 - AA doesn't want us to repeat speakers unless they're doing something new/fun
 - HP says plan for week 7 for now
- **DocSoc**
 - SA has reached out to DocSoc, who responded asking us to email them
 - HP thinks it should be possible early in the semester, perhaps week 5 (or whatever they suggest)
 - Not sure when they do their events
- **Winterbourne**
 - HP suggests Week 11 as a break from studying
 - Usually done during the holidays, where not many people are able to attend
 - JA mentions weather is usually cold when it's run
 - AA mentions it's usually unpredictable but more hopeful; no rush, so we can decide closer to the time
 - HP suggests a calendar reminder
- **Sponsor events**
 - Looks promising for a couple of sponsors
 - HP provisionally suggests week 5 time
